Passed, approved, and adopted by the Council of the City of Eureka, County of Humboldt, State of California, on the 7th day of June, 2007, by the following vote:



**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA
ESTABLISHING WATER RATE CHARGES**

NO. 2004-41

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Eureka, as follows:

WHEREAS, City Staff have analyzed the City's water treatment and delivery costs; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City's Water System to raise sufficient revenues to operate and maintain the system in accordance with public health requirements and without subsidy from the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has identified a number of Water System improvements that are necessary to insure an uninterrupted water supply to the City's customers; and

WHEREAS, the water fund's operational and maintenance reserves must be rebuilt to an adequate level of operating expenditures; and

WHEREAS, to address these funding needs City Staff prepared a water system cost of service analysis. This analysis was prepared to determine that the system user rates would adequately recover system operating costs and provide sufficient funds to meet planned water system infrastructure improvements. The new rates would continue the City's practice of recovering system costs from users in proportion to the demands each places upon the Water Utility System; and

WHEREAS, the proposed rate increases will provide approximately \$1,577,000 of additional water system

revenues by the end of fiscal year 2008-09. With these added revenues, future operating costs of the Water Fund will be adequately addressed; the Fund's operational and maintenance reserves will be rebuilt to a two month level of operating expenditures; the water system capital improvement fund is restored to provide funding for future system improvements.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved as follows:

Section 1. Water Service Charges.

(a) Service Charges. The monthly service charges for water service within the City shall be as follows:

(b) Quantity Charge. The Service Charge is a readiness to serve charge to which is added the charges for water used computed at the Metered Rates as set forth below. It is proposed these rates will be effective on September 1, 2004 and July 1st in 2005, 2006, 2007, and 2008.

WHEREAS, the Federal Government and the State of California require treatment facilities which
meet clean water standards; and
WHEREAS, the Federal and State Government have assisted in the financing of improved treatment
facilities; and
WHEREAS, the City of Eureka has provided matching funds in order to pay for the construction of
these facilities and operate the facilities; and
WHEREAS, the charges have been determined in a manner consistent with the State Clean Water
Grant Program; and
WHEREAS, City Staff has identified a number of sewer system improvements that are necessary to
maintain compliance with the State Clean Water Grant Program; and
WHEREAS, the sewer fund's operational and maintenance reserves must be rebuilt to an adequate level
of operating expenditures; and
WHEREAS, to address these funding needs City Staff prepared a sewer system cost of service
analysis. This analysis was prepared to determine that the system user rates would adequately recover system
operating costs and provide sufficient funds to meet planned sewer system infrastructure improvements. The
new rates would continue the City's practice of recovering system costs from users in proportion to the
demands each places upon the Sewer Utility System; and
WHEREAS, the proposed rate increases will provide approximately \$3,653,600 of additional sewer
system revenues by the end of fiscal year 2008-09. With these added revenues, future operating costs of the
Wastewater Fund will be adequately addressed; the Fund's operational and maintenance reserves will be
rebuilt to a two month level of operating expenditures; and the sewer system capital improvement fund is
restored to provide funding for future system improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the fees and charges will be as
follows:

SECTION 1. Sewer User Charges.

(a) Each user not required to obtain a wastewater discharge permit shall pay for each month, or fraction thereof, during which the premises is connected to the sanitary sewer, the applicable charge:

The Public Works Director and Finance Director may fix the monthly charge for public and private schools for the months of June, July, and August, based upon the usage of the sanitary sewer works.

(b) For each User who is issued a Wastewater Discharge Permit pursuant to Chapter 5, Article 4, Title 5 of the Butteka Municipal Code: a monthly User Charge consisting of a Customer charge, Peak Month Charge and Monthly Volume Charge as determined by the Public Works Director and Finance Director in accordance with the method prescribed by the Revenue Program Guidelines of the Water Resources Control Board of the State of California using the following unit charges applied to measured treatment parameters:

Peak Month Charges shall be applied to Peak Month Flow, BOD and SS discharges defined as the peak loading that the User discharges to the system during any calendar month during the previous fiscal year ending June 30 divided by the number of days of operation during that month. If the User is a new user to the system, the peak loadings to be used for the first annual billing period will be estimated and agreed upon by the User and City. If such estimates vary more than 10 percent of actual experience, an adjustment will be made to the User's bill in the following year with additional amounts or overcharges to be billed or credited in twelve equal monthly installments by the City to the User. The Monthly Volume Charges shall be applied to the Volume of sewage, BOD and SS discharged during the billing month.
