### **2006 THIRD QUARTER REPORT**

#### **I. RESPONSES**

08/20/2006-One Level II response to Humboldt State University for multiple exposures in Dorm at the request of on-scene agency Arcata Fire District. No product was found but it was believed to be irritant-Pepper Spray. HM-1 responded from HQ with 3 personnel, including 1 HM Specialist. A Haz Mat Group was established and entry made to investigate with a 4-gas monitor. No results were found. Victims with respiratory symptoms recovered outside the building.

#### **II. NON-RESPONSE INCIDENTS**

08/11/06-A consult was made by Captain Schultz with Captain Reynolds of Humboldt Fire District #1 for 2-30 gallon containers that were not leaking in the Freshwater area east of Eureka. Notification information was relayed and County resources assisted in clean-up.  
07/06/06-Eureka Fire Department consulted with the Eureka City Attorney regarding a request for release of public records related to a past Haz Mat incident.
