The City of Eureka’s Recreation Division and the Adorni Center are offering discounts for eligible participants. To become eligible one has to provide one of the following:

- Department of motor vehicle (DMV) permanently disabled identification card for parking.
- Social Security disability benefits eligibility verification, such as Social Security Income Payment Decision or Social Security Award Certificate.
- Disability Certification (Doctor must complete). Forms Provided by Recreation Division.

Drop-In Fees

Aerobic classes, weight lifting, cardio equipment and open gymnasium (basketball) are available to the public for a daily drop-in fee. Youth must be at least 15 years old to enter the cardio and weight rooms. Youth ages 8-12 years may participate in fitness classes when accompanied by an adult.

To be eligible for a disability discount, the applicant must possess one of the following disabilities:

- Developmental
- Hearing
- Mental
- Physical
- Speech
- Visual
